PUBLIC HEARINGS ON PROPOSED CHANGES TO ALABAMA ADMINISTRATIVE CODE. 290-8-9, Special Education Services.

Montgomery, AL. — The Alabama State Department of Education (ALSDE), Special Education Services, will conduct three public hearings on the proposed changes to the Alabama Administrative Code (AAC), 290-8-9, Special Education Services. The purpose of the hearing is to allow public comment on the proposed changes, as required by the *Individuals with Disabilities Education Act* and the implementing regulations. Each person will be allowed one-time opportunity to make a twominute public comment. If persons have additional comments, we encourage them to provide written comments to the address indicated below.
